

Secretarial report 2018-19

It was a great pleasure to work as secretary of IMA PCB for last 2 years from April 2017 to March 2019. It gave me a real boost to conduct the useful academic activities for all members through IMA-PCB and enjoyed exchanging my ideas and interacting with you to achieve many successful events.

Total membership of IMA PCB was 289 and now it is increased to 586. (including 162 couple membership.)
